

COVID-19 Operating Plan, prepared in compliance with 2021 RS HB1
For: All Barleycorn's Operations
Effective: April 1, 2020
Reference¹

1. Employees will stay home when appropriate.² Employees will have their temperature taken prior to the start of each shift.
2. Masks are mandatory, except for any person engaged in work that a state or federal regulator has concluded would make wearing a face covering a risk to their health or safety (back line cooks); and Any person who is seated and actively consuming food or drink.
3. We require frequent hand-washing of at least 20 seconds, at least once every 20 minutes from each staff member and any time gloves are removed, and gloves will be worn by staff when handling raw materials.
4. Adequate supplies will be ensured, including soap, hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol (placed on every station, if supplies allow), paper towels, tissues, disinfectant wipes, and no-touch trash cans.
5. We will post signs in highly visible locations (e.g., at entrances, in restrooms) that promote everyday protective measures for both employees and customers and describe how to stop the spread of germs.
6. Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces (e.g., door handles, cash registers, workstations, sink handles, bathroom stalls) at least daily, and as much as possible.
7. We will avoid using or sharing items that are reusable.
8. Use touchless payment options as much as possible, if available.
9. Encourage employees to cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue (or use the inside of their elbow). Used tissues should be thrown in the trash and hands washed immediately with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
10. In an effort to ensure distancing as recommended by the CDC, the facility will operate at 50% capacity, and will distance and stage tables in a way that ensures distancing of at least 6 feet between tables to ensure distancing between people not of the same household.

We believe that these practices and policies will foster the safety of employees, customers, attendees and patrons, including social distancing requirements, because they are consistent with the CDC Guidance, for our business.
